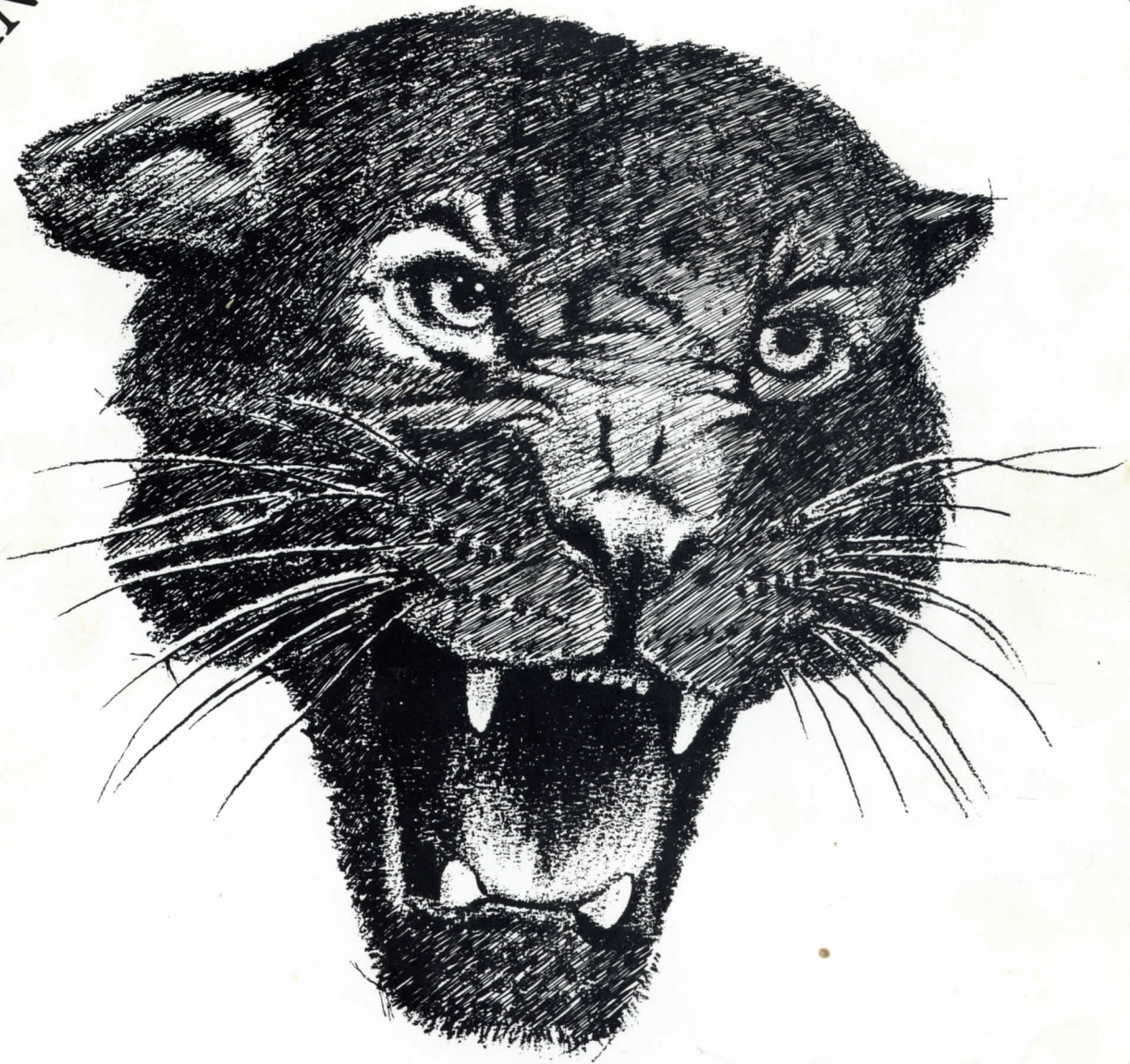

We were the quiet youth. We still believed in dreams, future mountains to climb, blue and white carnations, and a verse about friends the were either silver or gold.

Looking back. We were so young then one has to smile when remembering. We were friends, not too many were lovers. After all, we were before the pill, co-ed dorms, and the sexual revolution. Who are we now? Our hair has thinned; our waist lines have thickened; our armor tarnished and some of the ivy has been trampled; our dreams are fewer. We are grown-up, or so society tells us, and house payments, crooked teeth in need of braces; the price of food and children's tennis shoes reaffirm. We have joined the stream of life, middle age, and as the saying goes, a little older and a little wiser, perhaps.

"Nostalgia". We lived through "Happy Days" and we remember. 1976. Two hundred years for a country and fifteen years for us, the students of the Class of 1961, Antioch High. We will come together and we will again drift apart. We are human beings, we are survivors, and we are each unique. And in our own way we look back and we remember.

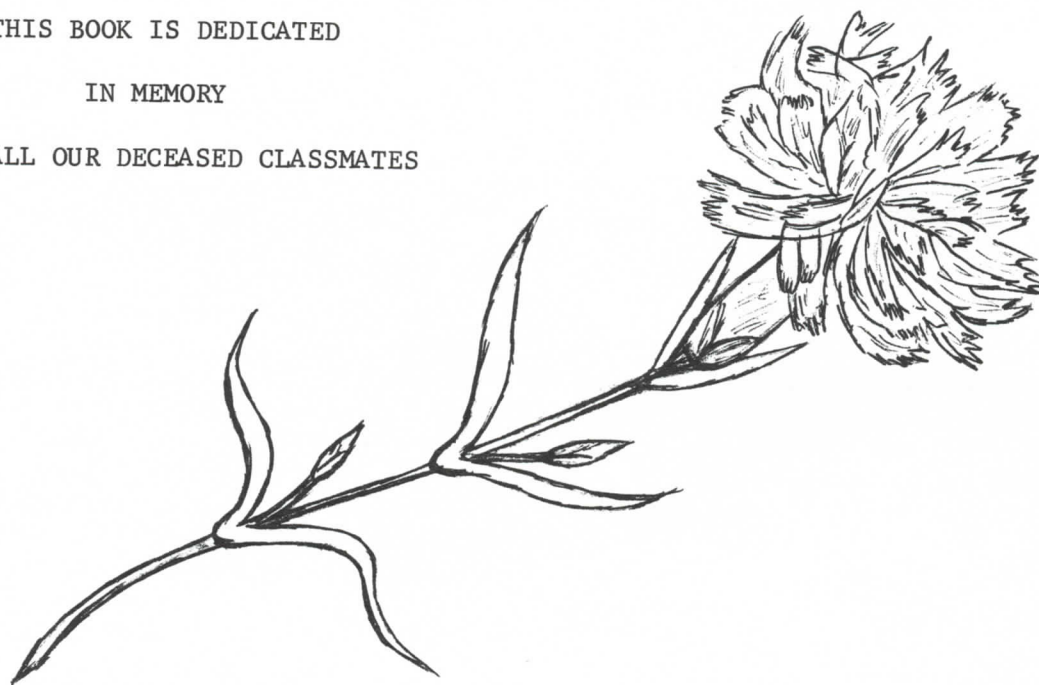
